### Fever-Tree's Tree House Garden Scoops Silver Medal at Chelsea Flower Show



UK drinks company *Fever-Tree* famed for their premium natural mixers, proved to be a huge success with celebrities who visited on press day yesterday but more important from a horticultural perspective is the feedback from the esteemed judges of the RHS who have awarded this garden a prestigious Silver Medal.

The main feature of the garden is the Tree House, made partly from reclaimed *cinchona* wood from the Congo. It was here that Rolls and Warrillow traced one of the last remaining plantations of *cinchona Ledgeriana* trees. The bark of these colloquially known 'fever trees' is removed, dried and ground to produce the highest quality natural quinine. Working directly with the plantation, Fever-Tree is the only drinks company to be using such high quality quinine in their tonic waters.



For Fever-Tree, taste is everything and in order to create the very best mixers Rolls and Warrillow have travelled extensively hunting for the highest quality natural ingredients for the mixers range.

The garden is intended to be a relaxing place for adults to unwind and savour a very British 'Gin & Tonic' whilst children can play safely in the tree house. All materials are recycled, found, borrowed or reclaimed and demonstrate that it is possible to build an interesting garden on a limited budget.
